Abstract	Cynthia Capers was the first black graduate of the University of Pennsylvania's nursing doctoral program, and has worked as a nurse, family therapist, consultant, researcher, professor, dean, and special assistant to the provost at the University of Akron. Cynthia Capers is a nursing leader recognized for her service as dean of the School of Nursing at the University of Akron, Chair of the Pennsylvania State Board of Nursing, a national advisor to the Johnson & Johnson Campaign for Nursing's Future, and a board member of the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education. She was the first black graduate of the University of Pennsylvania's nursing doctoral program.
