Eugene Conrad Elser (1944-) is a Professor of Law at Regent University School of Law in Virginia. He was born in Brooklyn, New York on May 22, 1944. Elser graduated with his B.A. in 1968 from Roberts Wesleyan College, and his M.A. (1970) and Ph.D. (1972) from Ohio State University, and his J.D. in 1979 from the University of Tennessee.
